When accessing the API using a cross-domain AJAX request (CORS), set this to the originating domain. This must be included in any pre-flight request, and therefore must be part of the request URI (not the POST body).

For authenticated requests, this must match one of the origins in the <code>Origin</code> header exactly, so it has to be set to something like <a href="https://en.wikipedia.org">https://en.wikipedia.org</a> or <a href="https://meta.wikimedia.org">https://meta.wikimedia.org</a>. If this parameter does not match the <code>Origin</code> header, a 403 response will be returned. If this parameter matches the <code>Origin</code> header and the origin is allowed, the <code>Access-Control-Allow-Origin</code> and <code>Access-Control-Allow-Credentials</code> headers will be set.

For non-authenticated requests, specify the value \*. This will cause the **Access-Control-Allow-Origin** header to be set, but **Access-Control-Allow-Credentials** will be **false** and all user-specific data will be restricted.
